☑ REVIEW

and, if needed, update storm and emergency protocols.



your emergency plan and protocols to all locations and drivers.

☑ REMIND

drivers of emergency resources, such as roadside assistance and insurance contact information.





yourself with which local radio and television outlets provide storm information and road closures.

☑ INDENTIFY

locations for vehicle storage in the event of flooding or lasting infrastructure damage.

☑ REVIEW

insurance policies that are in place and make any required updates or adjustments.



☑ ENSURE

all vehicles are equipped with emergency kits and that kit supplies have been replenished if needed.



✓ INDENTIFY

vehicles that are behind on routine maintenance, and ensure they are up to date to minimize risks of mechanical failures during emergencies.



all driver emergency contact information is updated.

☑ INDENTIFY

evacuation routes and make sure drivers are familiar with them.



☑ CONFIRM

that fuel cards have a storm profile set up and review process for changing card limits or obtaining emergency fuel deliveries.




☑ REVIEW

the emergency services and protocols your fleet management company offers, including how they handle after-hours and emergency calls.



☑ PREPARE

an emergency communications plan for the field that identifies when emergency protocols are activated and who is responsible for communicating next steps and updates to locations and drivers.
